This two-person showcase, featuring Philly painter Riley Hanson, and Frankfurt, Germany based multimedia artist James Gregory Atkinson, evokes the era of sackcloth and

eyeliner with Hanson portraits of period scenesters and Atkinson's closeup photos of teary eyes wearing “novelty” contact lenses.
