Weird *New Yorkers*, Deathly Drawings, and More Art This Week



Halo in a Hayloft

Opening Saturday, November 23
at [Lubov](#), 6 pm to 9 pm. On view
through January 5.

In a blurb for Noel Freibert's upcoming show at Lubov, Amanda Horowitz connects Freibert's dark, spidery drawings to her recent choice to start eating meat. "I'm sick of feeling like prey, and I'll consume some blood to understand that feeling a bit better," she writes. This very same prey (or predators, or neutral sentient beings, depending on your perspective)

populates Freibert's latest set of drawings, animal effigies captured in stark black ink. Freibert is no stranger to other species—a cursory scroll of his Instagram reveals he frequently dabbles in horse-human hybrids and other four-legged creations—but *Halo in a Hayloft* feels somehow darker, recalling the animalistic potential in us all or perhaps even a multi-species uprising.
